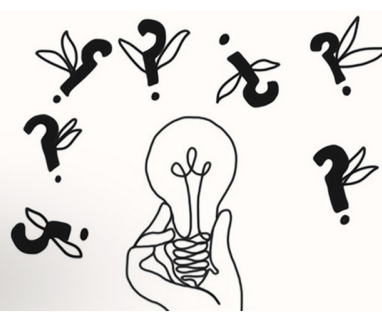


Online Information Session for prospective students

While the warmer temperatures and the progress being made with vaccinations are slowly bringing feelings of Spring, **the Summer semester at the IPU is fully underway**. Prospective students looking to start a course in psychology in Berlin during the 2021/2022 Winter semester **can now apply with us**. The next **Online Information Session** will take place on **8 June**, where you can learn all there is to know about our university and our study programs. In October, **the WIPU psychoanalytic training institute will open its doors for the first time**. Applications for WIPU are also open at this time.

At IPU, **hearings for three open professorships** will be happening soon. They will start on 21 May with candidates for the professorship in diagnostics in clinical psychology. After that, hearings for a junior professorship in theoretical psychoanalysis, subject and cultural theory will follow on 1 and 4 June. The hearings for the professorship in clinical developmental psychology with a focus on psychotherapy will then take place on 7 June.
