

Just before the start of the new Winter semester, the law on the reformation of psychotherapy training came into force in September. We have put together all the changes for you [here](#). In the Winter semester, all IPU students are welcome to participate in our Studium Generale courses. 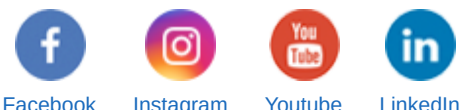
News from IPU's International Office

During the month of September, the International Office finalized partner agreements with two distinguished universities. The first is the **Afhad University for Women (AUW)**, which is located in Omdurman, Sudan and is – as its name reveals – an institution offering higher education to females. Their *School of Psychology & Pre-School Education* entails both under- and post graduate studies encompassing substantial focus on social trauma. Through their affiliated mental health and psychosocial service unit *Ahfad Trauma Center (ATC)*, the students of the university are offered close contact with the clinical field.

The second is **Universidad Andrés Bello**, which is located in the capital of Chile, Santiago de Chile. Its faculty of Humanities and Education offers graduate programs in Psychology, Sociology, Philosophy and Psychopedagogy. In addition, there are postgraduate programs in Adult Psychiatry and Psychiatric Rehabilitation, and a PhD program in Critical Theory and Actual Society.

Among our new partner universities is also one of the best private universities in South America, **Universidad de los Andes** (Bogotá, Colombia). Study programs at the Uni Andes, which might be interesting for IPU students are the graduate program in Psychology and the postgraduate programs M.A. Clinical Psychology, M.A. Peace Building and M.A. Cultural Studies. The university also offers a PhD program in Psychology.
