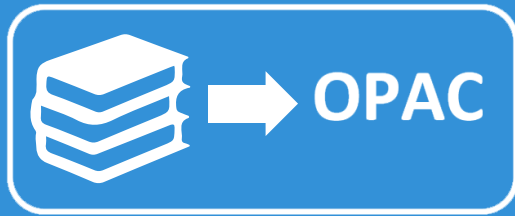

The IPU library stock is made up of many different medias. These resources can be found and used in several ways.

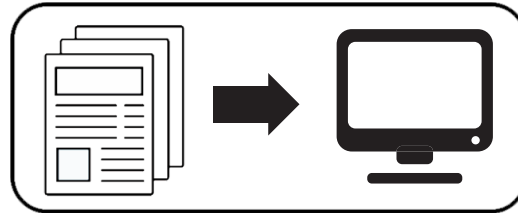
Print Sources at IPU



The library catalogue (OPAC) at IPU contains around 20,000 resources, first and foremost books and journals (some e-books).

- The catalogue is organized systematically and is available as open access. Sources can be located in the library shelves using the signature included in the OPAC.
- OPAC can be used to search for bibliographic information, not full-texts.
- Content searches are possible using key words and book title.
- Individual articles within books and series are not listed in OPAC

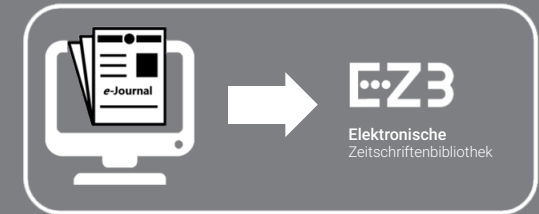
Scientific Articles



The scientific databases at IPU include primarily book chapters, journal articles, and test methods. Content is made available in either abstract or full-text form.

- Access through the library website (Research)
- If search results do not automatically show any full-text PDFs, that does not guarantee that IPU does not have access to the publications. It is possible the library has a print version of the work, which includes the desired article. (OPAC) In the case of an article from an online journal, check for possible access through the EZB.

Electronic Journals



Through national licenses and private subscriptions, IPU has access to around 1,000 full-text versions of online journals. In order to see whether a specific Journal is accessible to university members, refer to the Electronic Journal Library (EZB).

- Accessible through the library website (Research)
- Includes all online journals worldwide
- Direct link to journal's online edition
- Indicates IPU or other library licenses
