

IPU Berlin Hygiene Policy

The goals of the following protection measures are the reduction of contact on campus, protection of personnel and students from infection, as well as the greatest possible avoidance of smear infection from surfaces and objects. This can be ensured especially through attending to the minimum safe distance of 1.5m from others as well as increased cleaning and disinfecting routines.

Additionally, measures to control entrance, avoiding queues, and observing safe distance imperatives when waiting in groups will be enacted if necessary.

General Measures

- Follow safe distance rules (maintain at least 1.5m distance from other people)
- Wear mouth and nose coverings in all IPU buildings and rooms
- Avoid shaking hands, hugging, etc.
- Follow thorough hand hygiene through handwashing and disinfecting (especially after cleaning your nose, coughing, sneezing, contact with objects, and using the toilet)
- Collecting in groups in front of or within the campus area should be avoided. Students are required to leave the campus area in a timely manner after finishing their classes
- Make use of the disinfectant dispensers located around the campus
- Those with symptoms of acute respiratory sickness or with general flu-like symptoms (coughing, congestion, fever) and those who have been directed to quarantine may not enter the campus
- Restrooms may only be used one at a time
- All persons are required to provide their own protective materials

Organisational Measures

- If possible, rooms should be aired out regularly
- Where possible, building doors should be used only as either entrances or exits, and should be marked accordingly. The same is valid for hallways within buildings
- A responsible Corona representative will be appointed for every event. He/She is responsible for making efforts to ensure hygiene and safe-distance rules are being followed.

Carrying out Exams

- In exam rooms, the minimum distance of 1.5m between seats must be ensured
- Seats that may be occupied will be clearly marked
- There must be sufficient time (at least 60 minutes) planned between exam blocks to allow for departure and arrival, airing out, and cleaning surfaces.
- The supervisor is responsible for hygiene measures being followed during the exam and will create a list of all people present
