

Application Procedure

The deadline for handing in an application for the scholarship is set to **15 May 2022** at the latest.

Please note, that in order to send in the scholarship application, the candidate must have received an evaluation report from Uni-Assist, stating the grades in the German grading system as well as an application for either the **MA Psychology study course with a clinical focus** (English Track) or for the **MA Psychology focusing on Organisation** at the IPU Berlin, commencing in the winter semester 2022/2023.

As the application process for international students require several time-consuming steps, it is recommended that all prospective students who qualify for a potential scholarship, hand in their application for the **MA Psychology study course with a clinical focus** or for the **MA Psychology focusing on Organisation** to Uni-Assist **no later than 15 March 2022**. This ensures sufficient time for Uni-Assist to screen the applicant's documents.

Applying for the scholarship – Step by Step

Step 3: Gather all necessary documents for your application.

Step 4: Hand in your documents via [Uni-Assist](#) (15 March 2022, at the latest)

Step 5: If the application is complete, Uni-Assist will forward the application including the grades in the German grading system to IPU Berlin. At the same time applicants will receive an evaluation report from Uni-Assist which they can use to apply for this scholarship.

Step 6: Send in your scholarship application to the International Office, together with a copy of the evaluation report and proof of application to one of our two eligible programs commencing in winter semester 2022/2023.

Step 7: Admission letters will be sent to our new MA students. Two students will be selected for the scholarship based on the criteria mentioned above.
