


## Access to the IPU Library Electronic Resources


Click on the link for the desired database on the IPU library website.  
The following example uses "PEP-WEB."

When you click the link, you will be redirected to a page on which you will be required to use your IPU login as authentication.

This authentication is conducted through the IPU system. Your login information will not be collected by an external system, rather by idp.ipu-berlin.de.

The first time using this procedure, you will be required to consent to data protection regulations.

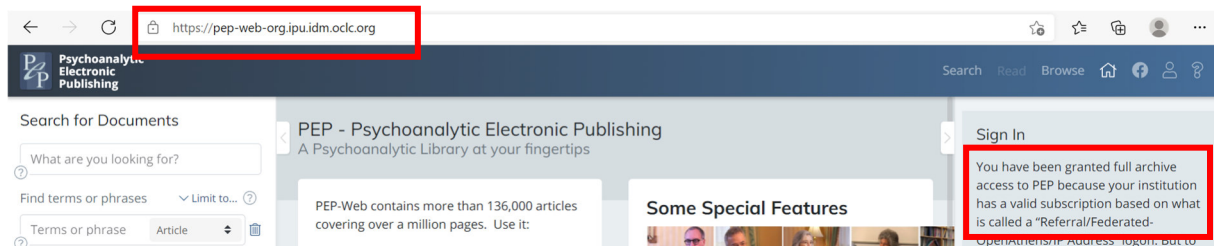
When you check the corresponding box, you will be shown the information that will be transmitted. You can see that no personal information will be shared—only the information “is an IPU member” and “has access to library resources.”

You will then be forwarded to the website <https://www.pep-web-org.ipu.idm.oclc.org/> and will be logged into PEP-WEB the same as if you were at IPU or connected to the VPN. You can recognize this by information in the right column that reads “You have been granted full archive access”.



Please note: You must always use the database links directly through the IPU website (or save them as bookmarks/favorites in your web browser). If you access PEP-WEB through [www.pep-web.org](http://www.pep-web.org), you will not have access to full versions of texts. You must use the address <https://ipu.idm.oclc.org/login?url=https://pep-web.org/> (link on the library website) and will be redirected from there.
