Program

This multidisciplinary program seeks to foster reflective social criticism in its students. You will explore transformation processes within organisational, environmental and health psychology, as well as their related areas.

Considering current complex global challenges, the significance of progress and growth in society's changing work environments must be rethought. Psychologists hold decisive roles in many professional fields by providing support to individuals and organisations that are coping with transitions and challenges of today's society. Issues such as social change, climate change, digitalisation and sustainability have brought all aspects of the status quo into question.

Work, Society, Environment are therefore not merely buzzwords; rather, they are highly intertwined concepts systematically focused on the dynamics in all relationships. Psychodynamic approaches are of central importance in understanding and guiding this global transformation.

Study Aim

As a graduate of this MA program, you will be equipped with theoretical and practical skills that allow you to develop sustainable solutions by reflecting on social dynamics and change processes. This program's integration of traditional learning and independent reflection fosters the ability to recognize and assume responsibilities, which accommodates the ability to make independent decisions in leadership positions.

This program encourages the development of communication skills through regular academic discussions and reflection. The curriculum is oriented primarily toward interactive teaching and learning.

You will learn how to conduct, present and discuss independent research and to deal constructively with criticism. Reflective attitudes regarding interdisciplinary and international dialogues hold particular importance and contribute to the development of a professional identity and ethical practices.
