There are many links between the 2023 films *Anatomy of a Fall* (Justine Triet) and *The Zone of Interest* (Jonathan Glazer): they are both not only driven by Sandra Hüller's minimalist acting style, but are also connected in the viewers' unconscious. Exploring these connections, **Psychoanalyst and author Andreas Hamburger** demonstrates his approach to **relational film analysis**, interpreting *Anatomy of a Fall* through the lens of *The Zone of Interest*. Clips from both films will be shown. Ample time will be given for Q&A with the audience.

Psychoanalyst Andreas Hamburger, PhD is a practicing psychoanalyst in Munich and Professor of Clinical Psychology and Psychoanalysis, International Psychoanalytic University, Berlin. His recent books, which focus on the intersection of film, psychoanalysis, and trauma studies, include *Screening the Scars: The Cinematic (In)visibility of Social Trauma* (forthcoming, Karnac); *From La Strada to The Hours: Suffering and Sovereign Women in the Movies* (Springer, 2024); and *Film Psychoanalysis: Relational Approaches to Film Interpretation* (Routledge, 2024; **20% discount code FPCN20**)

Adele Tutter, MD, PhD, a practicing psychoanalyst and Associate Professor of Psychiatry, Columbia University Vagelos School of Medicine, has published extensively on psychoanalysis and the arts.
